### **BLESSING OF HOMES**

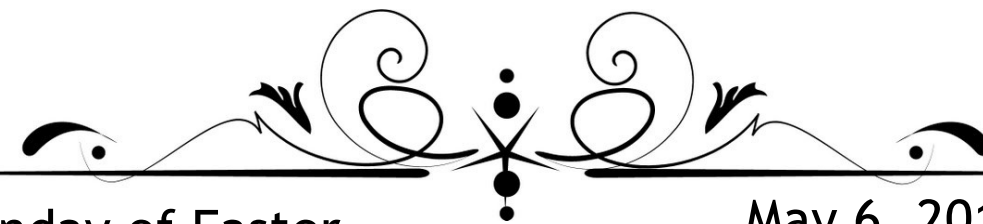
Easter season is traditionally a time for the blessing of homes. If you would like Father Vasek to bless your home, contact the parish office to schedule a convenient time.
