BLESSING OF FIELDS

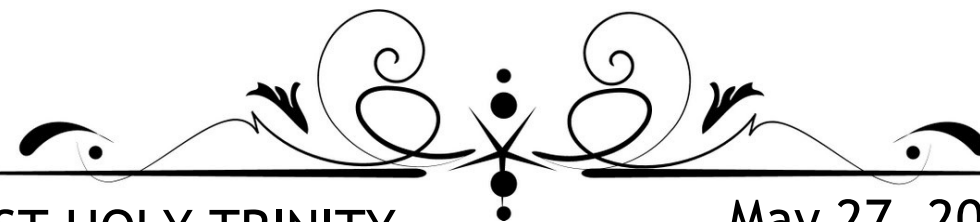

Masses can be requested from the parish at anytime, for the living or the dead, or for any good intention. A \$5 offering is customary for each request.

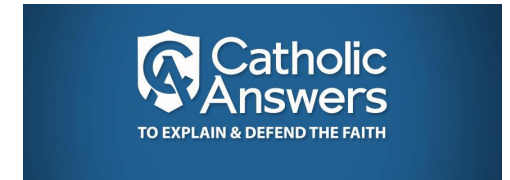
SUMMER IS HERE!
