PASTOR'S PEN

Dear Parish Family,

On this 61st anniversary of the World Day of Prayer for Vocations, also liturgically known as Good Shepherd Sunday, we are invited to pray for and promote all vocations. Initiated by Saint Paul VI during the Second Vatican Council in 1964, the purpose of this day is to help all of us respond to God's call and to support in prayer all those who are discerning how to best respond to the needs of today in the vocation God calls them to be.

World Day of Prayer for Vocations is often called an Annual Vocations Appeal in the Church. Every year, World Day of Prayer for Vocations falls on Good Shepherd Sunday. We see in Jesus, the Good Shepherd, the heart of every calling. He says, "A good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep." The mission of Jesus culminated in his self-sacrificing love. He gave himself so that we might live. This is the great mystery of love present in the Eucharist: "This is my body, given up for you. This is my blood, poured out for you." Everyone is called, and everyone has a vocation in the Church. Participating in parish life is a way individuals can discern their vocation and receive prayerful support from parishioners.

Dear Parishioners, this special day invites us to pray for and promote vocations to priesthood, and religious life. This providential initiative seeks to assist the members of the People of God, as individuals and as communities, to respond to the call and mission that the Lord entrusts to each of us in today's world, amid its afflictions and its hopes, its challenges, and its achievements. I encourage the parish community and families to celebrate and pray for vocations on this day.

The celebration of Christ the Good Shepherd today reminds us that we are shepherds, as well as flocks. This is because each one of us is occupying one leadership position or the other. So, who is a good shepherd, and where can we find one?
