## PASTOR'S PEN

Dear Parishioners,

*God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble* (Proverbs 3:34, James 4:6).

Everyone is invited to the table of the Lord, regardless of race, gender, culture, background, class, identity, income or any other unnecessary source of division. True humility requires that we acknowledge our weakness, our imperfections, our humanness. We are not more important than our neighbor. Humility begets generosity, as it recognizes the value in our neighbor especially those who are put down. When we invite the poor for meals, we tell them "you are valued, you are important, you are treasured." Aware of it or not, we are doing God's work when we do so.

True humility is not feeling bad about yourself, or having a low opinion of yourself, or thinking of yourself as inferior to others. True humility frees us from preoccupation with ourselves, whereas a low self-opinion tends to focus our attention on ourselves.

A humble person makes a realistic assessment of himself or herself without illusion or pretense to be something he or she is not. The humble regard themselves neither smaller nor larger than they truly are. The humble are not swayed by accidentals, such as fame, reputation, success, or failure. Humility is a virtue for people who already have self-esteem, not a substitute for it.

Model of humility in the person of Jesus Christ, *who emptied himself, taking the form of a servant, ...who humbled himself and became obedient unto death, even death on a cross* (Philippians 2:7-8).

Few questions we can ask ourselves: whom do I hold in high esteem? How does God regard me? How do I welcome those who cannot repay?
